Company CIS SCRL - CESAR Information Services, based in Brussels, provides a European wide harmonized interface between Combined Transport operators and their customers. CIS ensures the functioning of the CESAR-NEXT system, coordinates the integration of further customers and operators and is responsible for the set up of functionalities for trans-European communication with the customers and amongst the operators.

What is the principal of CESAR-NEXT?

CESAR-NEXT is based on CESAR platform which has been in Europe one of the largest tracking and tracing platform for combined transport in the last 20 years. Via the website (www.cesar-next.com), CESAR-NEXT provides you with the most up-to-date information on your loading units. Several operators all come as one virtual company with one single address where you can obtain status information about your loading unit no matter its position.



What are the advantages of CESAR-NEXT ?

A powerful tool for the most up-to-date information

- booked
- delivered in departure terminal
- loaded on wagon
- departed from departure terminal
- forecast unit pick-up at destination terminal
- ready for pick-up in arrival terminal
- pick-up completed in arrival terminal
- arrived for gateway in intermediary terminal

Find out the current status and updated forecast for unit pick-up (ETP) of all your loading units with the tracking and tracing functions

Once you are logged in and selected your language (English, French, German or Italian), you can retrieve information through queries, such as:

- by Customer Reference Number
- by Loading Unit
- by Terminal
- by Train
- Entire fleet

You will find the information about all your loading units no matter which CESAR-NEXT operator is handling them.

Besides the information on goods, Customs Seals, a historical list of the transport status is available and in case of a gateway, you can navigate between different transport legs. Some Operators are exchanging also additional transport legs modalities (road, short sea, barge, deep sea) in connection with rail transport section.

Find out about irregularities in case of incidents during the transport

In case of irregularities your operator will inform you by email or fax. Further information and updates are available when you log in to CESAR-NEXT.

The information provided by the operational departments of the operators, based on all available sources (information from railways, own agents, GPS...).

• Timetable and on-line booking – Link to Operator

Select one operator and then enter the individual operator-booking and timetable interface. Important notice: that these systems are specific to each operator. You can get in touch with one of the CESAR-NEXT operators for further information.

CESAR-NEXT offers interfaces for an easy integration into the customers own EDI systems. The data may be downloaded in an XML format for automatic or further manual processing.
